In order to increase the interest of students towards sports, the live telecast of the 2023-24 India-Australia Cricket World Cup Final was screened in University.




The accident that shocked the entire Kerala society happened during the "Dhishna" program in 2023, the union arranged counselling services for all those who need help to cope up with that disaster. The Union has submitted a petition to the Kerala Government seeking assistance to the families of those who have left us in the accident.



The working hours of the University Medical Center, on which the students depend, have been increased from 8 am to 6 pm to address the shortage of essential medicines.

The waste management system in the campus and inside the Sahrudaya Hostel was solved through green campus intervention. One of the most basic needs of the students is to replace the defunct water filters in Amenity and Hostel and replace the existing water filters.




North Indian KIOSK was started in the School of Engineering Campus by considering the demand of students from outside Kerala.

Sargam, the University Arts Fest was held on Feb 29, March 1,2,3 and 4. Sri. Arjun M .A. was Elected as the General Secretary of the committee. The first reception committee meeting was held on February 15 with the participation of students and teachers. This years event featured 150 events over five days. The Union took initiative to increase the number of events from 76 to 109. Minister for Higher Education Dr. R Bindu released the logo of Sargam 2024. Renowned film actor Subeesh Sudhi inaugurated the festival. Students from Zone 3, Zone 4 and Zone 1 bagged the first, second and third positions respectively.










At the request of the Union, the Eduroam system was set up inside the seminar complex, as a first step in the implementation of Eduroam, a global internet facility that is one of the basic needs of students.



In the first phase of integration, the RF ID system has been introduced inside the library. As per the request of the union, every department has arranged a system inside the library, so all the students can use it successfully.

The notification inviting Magazine theme from the students was issued on May 4.and S. Advaita proposed a theme, 'Re-defining Constitutional Morality through Arts and Science'. The Union Magazine release was held on 14 October.






Steps have been taken to rectify the deficiencies in the existing payment gateways and consolidate them and display the relevant instructions in the Departments and in Hostels.


Following the union's request for more seating inside the campus, necessary steps have been initiated to install seating along with fencing at Milma.




Though all arrangements were made to conduct the inter-college basketball tournament under the union, the tournament was postponed due to technical reasons.

The renovation work of the basketball court in the arena and the basketball court in front of Sanatan Hostel was done by union intervention.





The tender process, which is the first phase of the repair, is underway following a petition filed by the union demanding the repair of roads in the university.




The union submitted a request to hold the convocation at the University level, but due to some technical reasons, it could not be held at the University level. The Union then takes initiative to conduct the Convocation in the Departments and prepare the activities for that.

The intervention of the union helped to speed up the repair of the elevator in Amenity and to make it convenient for the students.

On the issue of charging lab fees from Departments without labs like Hindi, it has been decided to include labs by modifying the syllabus.

In the wake of the decision to hold a Food Fest under the leadership of the Union, the Wayanad landslide disaster occurred in Kerala and the Union came forward with a campaign called 'Samsara', in the first phase of which it sold about 600 Biryanis through the Biryani Challenge inside the campus and Rs. 30000/- to the CMDRF.



On 12th August, the cover page of the magazine was released at CUCEK campus and related events were held.

Union had decided to hold the second edition of the Cochin University Film Fest On july 29,30,31 and August 1. But the event had to be stopped on July 30 th due to the Wayanad disaster. The event was rescheduled for August 11 and 12. The jury panel for the second edition of CFF consisted of renowned Sri. Jeo Baby, Sri. Tom Emmatty and Sri. Vishnu Govind. Acting under the leadership of directors renowned film actor Sri. Rajesh Sharma as one of the affiliate programs of CFF Workshop, quiz and treasure hunt were conducted. The cast and crew of the film, which won several awards including as part of the CFF, were present on the stage. the National Award
