The Standing Scientific Commission (SWK), the advisory body of the Conference of Ministers of Education in Germany, has put forth a comprehensive set of recommendations to address the challenges faced by schools in the context of current political crises. These recommendations aim to enhance the educational framework by providing both immediate support and laying the groundwork for sustained, long-term improvements in

democracy education.

Here a summary:

For mid-term changes, they propose recommendations focused on enhancing the subjects of politics and history, integrating democracy education across curricula, and promoting democratic school development. They also emphasize fostering a democratic school culture through participation and decision-making opportunities for students and parents.

Another suggestion:

Strengthening teacher education in democracy education, both for subject teachers and broadly, is identified as crucial, with a call for university-anchored further education for career changers and non-traditional entrants (in German language: Quer- und Seiteneinsteiger).
