- Always use eco friendly materials like leaves, flowers etc for decoration and while making bouquets for felicitating guests. Avoid using plastic wrapper for bouquets
- Avoid open burning of waste . Use paper shredder for disposal of paper waste
- Greening activities of campus to be carried out involving students
- Functions hosted at CUSAT to abide by green protocol.
- Save natural resources like water & electricity.

NOW THE AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS

- 1. Land area for planting of tree saplings shall be as earmarked by the University and the planting of saplings shall be in the land adjacent to the Centre of Budget Studies of Cochin University of Science and Technology.
- 2. The Division of Social Forestry shall plant 260 fruit saplings sponsored to them by the Nippon Motor Corporation Pvt. Ltd., HMT Junction Kalamassery in the land allocated by the University.
- 3. The Division of Social Forestry shall initiate land preparation and plant the one year old tall tree saplings which have a higher survival rate.
- 4. The University shall undertake maintenance and upkeep of the saplings planted for the next 5 years.
- 5. There shall not be any other financial commitment to the University based on the agreement.
- 6. The University shall retain ownership and control of the designated land and the Division of Social Forestry shall have no claim over the land.
- 7. In case of requirement of cutting of planted trees due to growth to dangerous levels or any other reasons, required permission may be obtained from the Office of the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Department of Social Forestry
