The Government Order read above regarding the reservation for admission to Post Graduate & Degree Courses (Appended) is implemented in the University.



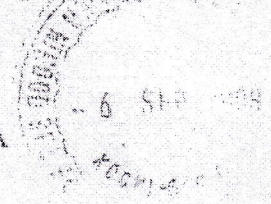

ORDER

As per Government order read as 2nd paper above 20% reservation was introduced for the students belonging to backward classes in degree and Post Graduate courses in Government colleges based on the findings of the Narendran Commission Report. The above said Government Order was kept in abeyance as per the letter read as 3rd paper above in view of the finding that total reservation exceeds 50% which is against the order of the Supreme Court.

As per the Government Order read as 4th paper above 3% reservation to Physically Handicapped students was incorporated in the community based reservation in order to overcome the difficulty of total reservation exceeding 50%. This Government Order could not be implemented since admission process had already started. Government issued instructions not to implement the reservation in Degree and Post Graduate courses until further orders and to maintain status quo vide letter read as 5th paper above.

In the circumstances Government have seriously considered the matter of extending the reservation to backward classes in this academic year itself. It is observed that the number of seats in Colleges and University Departments have to be enhanced to provide reservation to backward classes as per existing rules of reservation since classes for this academic year have already commenced.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order the following.

- 1) 20% of the total seats existing in Government Colleges and University Teaching Departments will be enhanced and allotted to the communities belonging to backward classes. The percentage of reservation will be as follows.

- Ezhava - 8%
- Muslim - 7%
- L.C/S.L.U.C - 1%
- O.B.C Christian - 1%
- O.B.C Hindu - 3%

- 2) Thiyya and Billava will be considered as Ezhava Community for the reservation.
- 3) Ezhava community is excluded from the reservation to O.B.C. Hindu Category. Since separate reservation has been provided to that Community.
- 4) For backward classes Annual Family Income will be below Rs.2.5 lakhs for getting the benefit of reservation.
- 5) The B.P.L. Certificate issued by the Village officer will be considered as the certificate of economic backwardness.
- 6) 3% of the total seats will be set apart exclusively for physically handicapped candidates. The remaining seats will be considered as one single unit for providing reservation mentioned in this Government Order.
- 7) The financial assistance now provided to Muslim and Nadar girls will be extended to the girls from other backward communities also.
- 8) The enhancement of additional seats in Government Colleges and University Departments will not incur any additional financial commitment to Government.
- 9) The Government orders cited 2nd and 4th and Government letters read above will stand cancelled.
